On 02/16/2018, at approximately 1512 hours, while working uniformed patrol in a fully marked Seattle Police vehicle as unit 2-GEORGE-2, I was dispatched to Garfield High School located at 400 23 Av, to investigate threats that were made from a student to shoot students. MDT call notes read as follows: "2ND HAND FROM ANOTHER STUDENT, SUSP TOLD SUBJ HE PLANS TO PULL THE FIRE ALARM AND SHOOT AND SHOOT STUDENTS, OCCURRED 2 WEEKS AGO, SUSP POSTED DISTURBING POST ON FACEBOOK TODAY, COMPL REQ OFFICERS CHECK SUSPS ADDRESS/SUSP DIDNT ATTEND SCHOOL TODAY".

I arrived at the dispatched address where officers and I contacted Garfield High School staff. We were escorted to a conference room, where VICTIM/ [REDACTED] WITNESS/ [REDACTED] and WITNESS/ [REDACTED] and COMPLAINANT/ [REDACTED] were seated. I was informed by [REDACTED], who at the time was working for Garfield High School, that [REDACTED] had reported another student had made threats to shoot students.

I contacted [REDACTED] who informed me that ARRESTED/ [REDACTED], [REDACTED], had made threats to shoot students at Garfield High School. [REDACTED] stated he was unsure of the exact date the statements were made; however, [REDACTED] informed me it occurred approximately one month to three weeks ago. [REDACTED] stated on the fifth period, during statistics class, [REDACTED] was viewing graphic and violent videos about people dying on his cellphone from Reddit.com. [REDACTED] showed the videos to several classmates, including [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] found the videos to be amusing and fun. [REDACTED] stated he felt uncomfortable watching the videos, and confronted [REDACTED] about it. [REDACTED] stated he told [REDACTED] to stop watching the videos. [REDACTED] became upset, and confronted [REDACTED]. The situation escalated, [REDACTED] informed me at this time, [REDACTED] began to make

statements about shooting the school. ██████ stated he would pull the school's fire alarm, and wait for the students to exit the building; once the students made their way out to the field behind the school, he would begin shooting students.

██████ stated ██████ attempted to down play the statements, by saying he was simply joking. ██████ informed ██████ the statements made were not funny, and he was afraid. ██████ stated other student who witnessed this, also believed ██████'s threats. Because ██████ confronted ██████ ██████ informed ██████ he would be at the top of the kill list. ██████ stated "at the time I took it lightly, but deep down I was very scared".

██████ informed me, after ██████ made these statements, he approached his teacher, ██████, ██████. ██████ informed ██████ of the statements made by ██████, and that he feared ██████ would follow through with his threats. ██████ stated ██████ nervously laughed, and disregarded the information that was given to her.

No documentation of this incident was reported by ██████. Aside from informing ██████, ██████ did not report this to any other Garfield High School staff.

██████ stated ██████ later advised several students and him, to add him on Snapchat. ██████'s reason for this, was to warn them before he followed through with his plan to shoot the school.

██████ stated he and other students added ██████ on Snapchat. ██████ informed me ██████ posted several things on Snapchat which he considered odd. However, on 02/16/2018, ██████ posted an image of a revolver with a student's face coming out of the barrel. The Snapchat post stated something in the lines of, screenshot if you think there should be more guns. ██████ stated that he screenshot the post because he feared what could happen if he did not. ██████ stated he feared ██████ would become suspicious if he did not screenshot the post.

██████ immediately reported the screenshot to school staff, once he saved it on his cellphone. I observed the screenshot on ██████'s cellphone. I photographed the cellphone and uploaded the photograph to DEMS. ██████ submitted a written statement to Garfield school staff.

██████ informed me, that even though they were not close friends, he and ██████ interacted during fifth period. Both sat close to each other near the back of the classroom. However, ██████ informed me that after he confronted ██████ regarding the threats made, ██████ began to see ██████ less and less. ██████ began to sit near the front of the classroom, then slowly began to miss classes. ██████ noticed ██████ was not around as much as before. ██████ stated he did not see ██████ at school today, but a friend of his did.

[REDACTED]'s friend, [REDACTED] approached [REDACTED] and stated "bro, I think he just snapped", referring to [REDACTED].

I asked [REDACTED] if he would be willing to provide a voluntary recorded statement, regarding the threats made by [REDACTED], [REDACTED] agreed. The statement was recorded with BWV and using digital recorded, which was uploaded to DEMS.

During the recorded statement, [REDACTED] stated he has known [REDACTED] since the sixth grade, but has not had a class with him until now. [REDACTED] informed me the only class they have together is fifth period. [REDACTED] stated the times he has interacted with [REDACTED], he has never observed any type of violent behavior. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has a dark humor but is mostly regarding politics. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as opinionated, also being quiet, but not someone that usually keeps to himself. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has friends and is heavily involved with the Mount Baker rowing crew.

At one point during the recorded interview, I observed [REDACTED] tear up, in fear of what [REDACTED] was capable of doing.

I then interviewed [REDACTED], who at the time was working as a school counselor. [REDACTED] informed me she has been counseling [REDACTED] for several years, because he has been having a difficult time at home and school. Refer to SPD case #17-143901 for previous domestic violence incident. [REDACTED] began to have difficulty focusing at school, his school grades deteriorated, he was unable to engage in classes. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] to seek professional counseling, but she is unaware if [REDACTED] did receive counseling. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as "a nice kid that is just suffering".

While I interviewed [REDACTED] we were informed by vice principal [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] submitted a letter of resignation. [REDACTED] stated the letter was submitted on 02/16/2018, which took [REDACTED] by surprise.

Sgt. Traver who was on scene, screened this incident with Sgt. Worstman in Homicide and Lt. Ballingham in Intel.

Once the investigation was completed at Garfield High School, officers and I contacted [REDACTED] at his residence. [REDACTED] answered the door and appeared to be surprised to see officers at his door. [REDACTED] identified himself, by name. [REDACTED] was placed under arrest, at this time, he apologized for having made threatening comments to his classmates. [REDACTED] stated he was not serious about the threats made.

En route to East Precinct, [REDACTED] was advised Miranda Rights along with Juvenile Warnings, from department issued Miranda card.

Officers informed [REDACTED] 's mother, [REDACTED] would be booked into YSC, and gave her the phone number for YSC.]
