This Court, having certified for election four recall charges filed against Councilmember Kshama Sawant by Mr. Ernest Lou, and having reviewed the briefing on the proposed modifications to the ballot synopsis by parties filed on September 18, now rules as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that the following shall be the ballot synopsis:

3 Shall the City of Seattle Councilmember Kshama Sawant be recalled from office for
4 misfeasance, malfeasance, and violation of the oath of office based upon charges that are upon
5 based upon allegations that she violated the city charter, city code and state law when she:

- 6 (1) Delegated City employment decisions in her Council office to a political organization
7 outside the City government;
- 8 (2) Used City resources to support a ballot initiative and failed to comply with the public
9 disclosure requirements related to such support;
- 10 (3) Disregarded state orders related to COVID-19 by admitting hundreds of people into
11 City Hall on June 9, 2020 when it was closed to the public;
- 12 (4) Led a protest march to Mayor Jenny Durkan's private residence, the location of which
13 Councilmember Sawant knows is protected under state confidentiality laws.
